Varma, "Jewish Synagogue"- Scrolls of the Old Testament and copper plates inscribed in Hebrew script are preserved here, "Jews Street", "St. Francis Church"- built in 1503, is the oldest European church in India and has great historical significance. The Portuguese explorer, Vasco da Gama, died in Kochi in 1524, his body was originally buried in this church, but after fourteen years his remains were removed to Lisbon, "Santa Cruz Basilica" - This Roman Catholic church has beautiful paintings on the ceiling, "Chinese fishing nets" and the "Indo-Portuguese Museum". 

The King is so much attached to his kingdom that it is believed that he comes annually from another world to see his people living happily. It is in honour of King Mahabali that Onam is celebrated.
